Important Notes

Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) Eligibility

An ATAR is the primary mechanism used nationally for tertiary admissions and indicates a student's position relative to other students. To be eligible for an ATAR, students will have to:

- Satisfactorily complete an English subject
- Complete five General subjects or
- Complete four General subjects plus one Applied subject or VET course Certificate III or above.

If intending to apply for university study, students should ensure their Year 11/12 subjects meet the pre-requisites already published for courses commencing in 2021. University pre-requisites are available online at qtac.edu.au/atar-my-path/my-path or from the Guidance Officer.
