Operating Theatre Technician

With this qualification you could
work as a Theatre Support Officer.

Theatre Support Officers (also known as Operating Theatre Technicians) assist in making sure the theatre and equipment within the operating theatres at Sunshine Coast Health are clean and in working order. They also provide support throughout the surgical journey, ensuring patient safety during transport of patients between the theatre and wards, including assisting with positioning and moving patients in the operating theatre.

Pharmacy Assistance

Certificate III in Hospital or Health
Services Pharmacy Support

Pharmacy Technicians support hospital pharmacists and help them manage pharmaceutical services and supplies. Their responsibilities can include buying, storing and maintaining medicine supplies and other items in the hospital.
