In 2022 Burnside Volleyball is off to a very strong start with our involvement in the Sunshine Coast Volleyball Championships (Trish Buckley Shield), and the selection of our 5 Regional Representatives.

Sunshine Coast Schools Volleyball Championships (Trish Buckley Shield) BURNSIDE FINISHES WITH 1 x GOLD MEDAL and 3 x 2nd and 2 x 3rd and a 5th from our 7 teams at Senior Trish Buckley Shield

Four rounds of the Senior Sunshine Coast competition at Caloundra Indoor Stadium were completed during term 1 with great results from all our Burnside teams.

Team results were: Year 12 Girls – 2nd, Year 12 Boys – 2nd, Year 11 Boys – 2nd, Year 11 Girls – 3rd, Year 10 Girls – 3rd, Year 10 Boys 1 – 1st Gold medallists (Sunshine Coast Champions), Year 10 Boys 2 – 5th.

2022 AUSTRALIAN VOLLEYBALL SCHOOLS CUP

Dates: Depart Sunday 5 December Depart Gold Coast Saturday 11 December

There are only **32** weeks remaining before we depart for the **2022 Australian Volleyball Schools Cup** on the Gold Coast.

What a great week that's going to be! Our teams will be traveling to the Gold Coast from the 4 - 10 December to compete against the best in Australia.

The team lists for Year 8-12 for the 2022 Australian Volleyball Schools Cup are in the process of being finalised. We currently have 7 Teams – Year 12 Boys, Year 11 Boys, Year 10 Girls, Year 9 Boys, Year 9 Girls, Year 8 Boys, Year 8 Girls and hopefully a Year 7 Boys and Girls team.

Only those teams with adequate numbers of players (minimum of 8) and who paid a deposit and returned the permission form for the event are eligible to attend.

Players can be removed from the team list if they fail to make payments on time, have a major injury, have poor behaviour at school, etc.

The prices below are based on transport and accommodation from the Sunshine Coast and return.

A few details of the trip are:

- Opening Ceremony on the Sunday with matches running from Monday Saturday.
- The main venues include the Coomera Indoor Sports Centre and the Gold Coast Sport and Leisure Centre.
- Our accommodation is excellent at the Sandcastles on the Broadwater which is fully self-contained so students can save money by catering for their meals
- Parents of players are encouraged to contact us if they wish to be considered as managers or parent helpers for this week we want 1 parent helper per team at AVSC '22
- This will be Burnside's 27th trip to the AVSC!!!!!

The cost of the trip to AVSC '22 on the Gold Coast this year is \$590.00, which includes Mini bus rental/transport, 6 night's apartment accommodation, Team nomination and Duty Bond, and a Burnside Volleyball AVSC 2022 dress shirt. We will collect a cash payment of \$80 per player at a date closer to departure to cover the cost of food and fuel for each team.

The second payment is due on 16th June (\$200) and third on the 9th September (\$190). Any balance owing is paid on the 11th November. (Inc. all other school fees must have been paid for students to be eligible for involvement)
