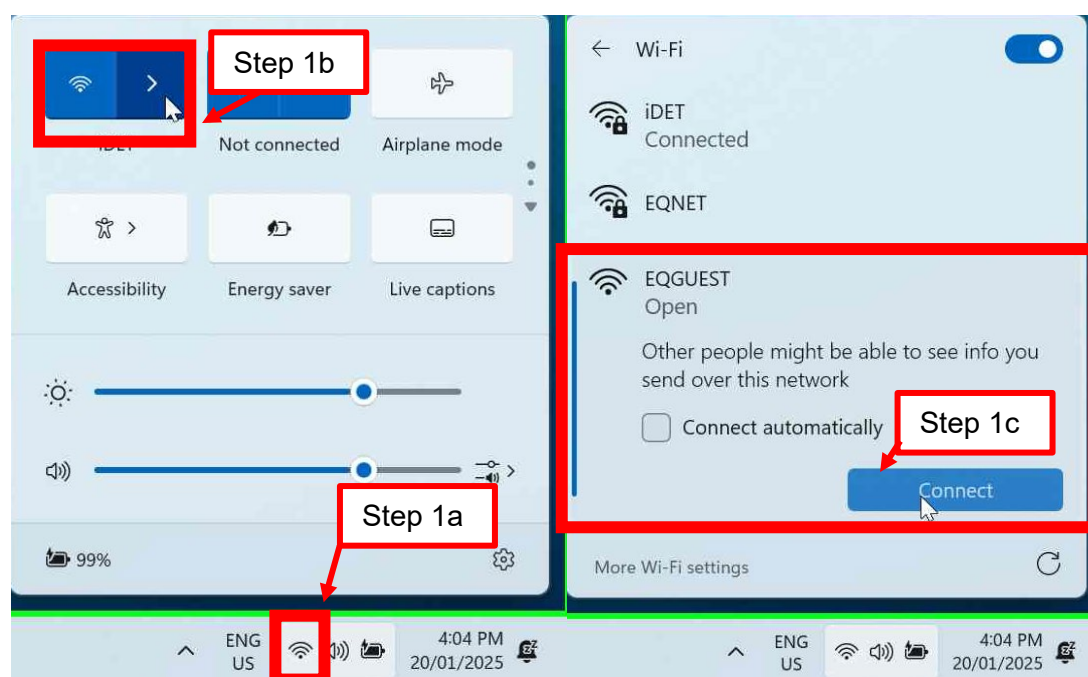
Use guest Wi-Fi service to connect a Windows device

This document explains how to connect a visitor's Windows device to the school guest Wi-Fi network (EQGUEST). The connection is limited to the filtered internet service and will be available to use for two hours.

Use your school account to log in.

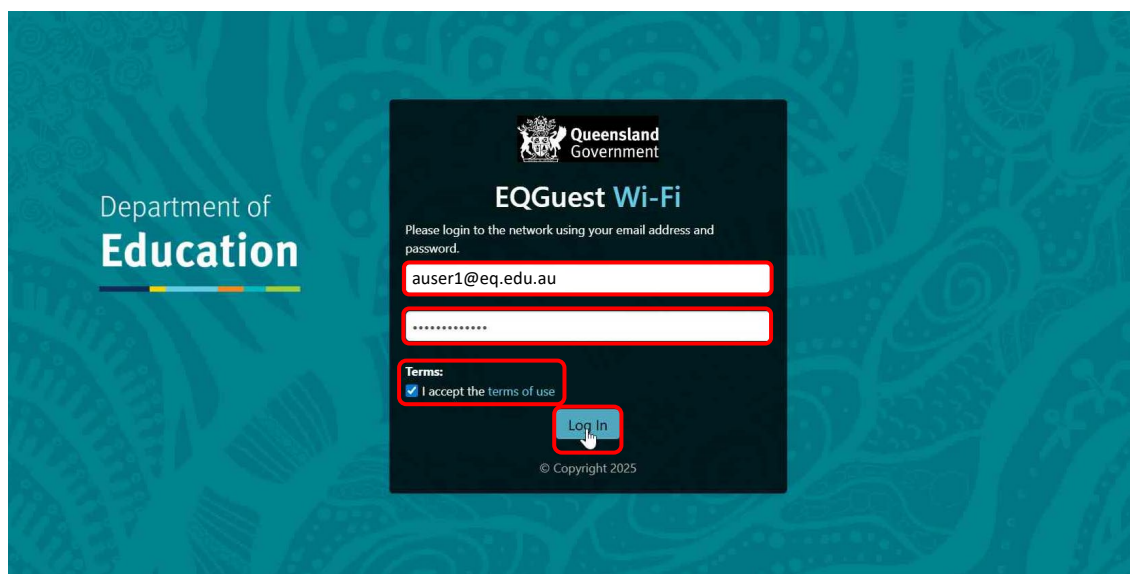
Step 1. Connect to EQGUEST Wi-Fi network

- Select the  Wi-Fi icon at the bottom right of the screen.
- Select the > button next to the Wi-Fi networks.
- Scroll the Wi-Fi networks to select EQGUEST. Select **Connect**.



Step 2. Sign in to EQGUEST Wi-Fi network

- a. A sign on page will be displayed.
- b. Enter your school email address.
- c. Read and accept the **terms of use** by ticking the box.
- d. Select **Log In**.
- e. A success screen will be displayed.
